The Crown table in Coffee are cast in one piece formed as a circular table top carried by four cylinder shaped legs. Standing strong and proud, the table is inspired by the bare, structural elements of Brutalist architecture, celebrating the columns, and eluding an attitude towards too many details.

The chunky fiber concrete legs enable a large gap between the table edge and legs to emphasize the experience of a massive floating table top.

With its sculptural presence and impeccable craftsmanship, the Crown Table seamlessly integrates into both residential and commercial spaces, offering a timeless expression of modern simplicity. Combine the tall Crown table with the low Crown table for a dynamic and layered expression. Place as a coffee table or statement piece in a lounge, lobby, or living space.

Together, they craft design that transcends time, poetic yet practical, expressive yet enduring.



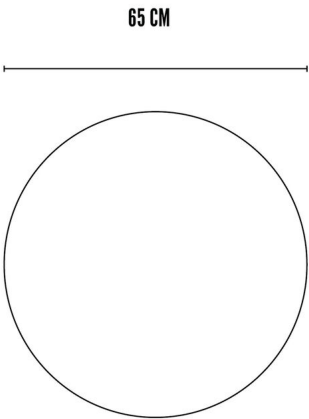
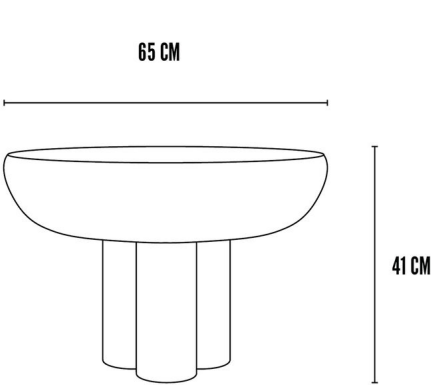

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Family Description Text

The Crown Collection rises from the spirit of Brutalist architecture, where form is stripped to its essence and structure becomes poetry. Whether placed in a private home or a public space, Crown does not simply furnish a room but inhabits it, offering a timeless expression of simplicity, weight, and grace.

Color Description

Hand-painted in a deep, warm dark brown, this shade evokes the richness of earth and roasted beans. Its grounded elegance lends both warmth and depth, while brush stroke variations bring gentle shifts in tone and texture, making each piece entirely unique.

Maintenance Guide Description

Hand-painted fiber concrete is strong and resilient, yet its artisanal finish requires thoughtful care. Dust surfaces regularly with a soft cloth, and for routine cleaning, use a damp cloth with mild, pH-neutral soap, then dry thoroughly. Avoid abrasive pads, solvents, or acidic and alkaline cleaners, as these can damage the hand-painted layer.

Always protect surfaces with coasters, mats, or felt pads to prevent scratches, stains, and heat marks. Wipe spills immediately to reduce the risk of absorption, and avoid prolonged exposure to standing water. To preserve its finish, keep furniture away from direct sunlight, high humidity, and extreme temperature changes.

With simple, mindful care, hand-painted fiber concrete furniture will maintain its unique character, depth, and elegance for years to come.
