Together, they craft design that transcends time, poetic yet practical, expressive yet enduring.



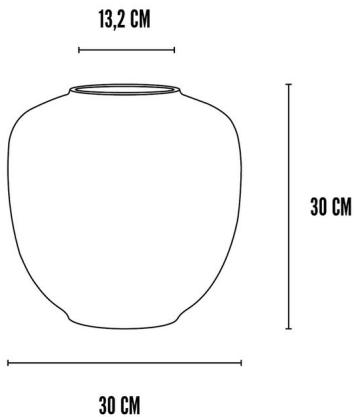

Maroon is a deep, rich shade a dark reddish-brown created by blending red with brown or darkening red with a touch of black. Its name comes from the French marron, meaning "chestnut," echoing its warm, earthy core.

It carries the quiet strength of seasoned wood and the softness of dusk's last ember. Poised between passion and calm, Maroon evokes sophistication, depth, and a grounded, enduring warmth.

Maintenance Guide Description

Our hand-painted ceramic pieces are crafted as decorative objects, designed to age gracefully when cared for with gentleness.

The outer surface of our pieces is hand-painted and should be treated with the same reverence dust lightly with a soft, dry cloth, allowing the painted character to remain untouched. Water, harsh cleaners, or abrasives should never meet this surface, as they can disturb its delicate finish.

Vases are sealed within and may hold water for fresh flowers. Clean their interiors gently with lukewarm water, then dry carefully, taking care that no moisture touches the painted exterior.

To preserve their vibrancy, keep each piece away from prolonged sunlight and sudden shifts in temperature. With such mindful care, every ceramic piece will hold its artistry, warmth, and timeless presence for years to come.
