Named after the Japanese word for "generous," the Hiro Dining Chair embodies understated elegance and inviting comfort. Its sculptural three-legged design is inspired by minimalist art, transforming the chair into a striking spatial object with harmonious proportions and a pure, considered silhouette.

A cylindrical backrest doubles as a discreet handle, encouraging fluid movement and adaptability in everyday settings. The composition celebrates clarity of design meeting the warmth of craftsmanship - in a single, generous gesture.

The matte black powder-coated steel frame offers a smooth, refined surface with lasting resistance to wear and fading. Paired with this structure is Peat wool velvet - a deep smoky brown touched with dark grey and earthy undertones - whose dense pile catches the light softly, adding quiet depth and tactile richness. Together, black frame and Peat velvet create a timeless interplay of shadow and earth: sophisticated, textured, and quietly atmospheric.

Perfect around a dining table, at the head of a meeting space, or as a standalone accent in an entryway, the Hiro Dining Chair brings sculptural presence and quiet luxury to any setting.

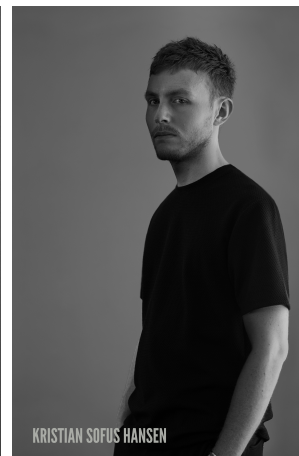
Designer Description

Together, they craft design that transcends time, poetic yet practical, expressive yet enduring.



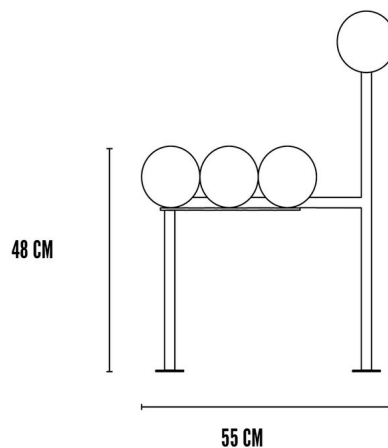
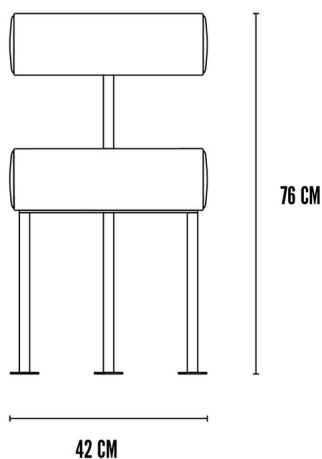

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Family Description Text

The Hiro Collection is named after the Japanese word for "generous," and that spirit of generosity is expressed in every detail. Inspired by minimalist art and the quiet elegance of Japanese design, it transforms pure geometry into something sculptural, tactile, and welcoming.

Repeating cylindrical shapes create a shared rhythm across the pieces. The bench sits low and grounded, supported by two legs, each formed from four upholstered cylinders gathered together like soft architectural columns. The dining chair contrasts this softness with three cylindrical metal legs, giving it a poised and deliberate stance, while rounded upholstered volumes offer comfort with restraint.

Together, the pieces shape a quiet dialogue between structure and softness, weight and lightness. The Hiro Collection does not seek attention. It settles into a space, bringing warmth, stillness, and a sense of generosity through thoughtful presence.

Color Description

This pairing balances the depth of a pure black frame with the grounded richness of Peat velvet. The velvet's deep smoky brown, touched with dark grey and softened by earthy undertones, brings warmth and natural depth. Its velvety surface catches the light softly, adding a sense of depth and quiet luxury to the color. It recalls soil that has remembered centuries, weathered wood, and the calm of damp earth after rain.

The black frame sharpens the composition with clean contrast, while the peat tone introduces a soft, tactile richness. Together, they create a timeless interplay of shadow and earth, sophisticated, textured, and quietly atmospheric.

Maintenance Guide Description

This piece brings together the durability of powder-coated stainless steel with the soft richness of velvet. Each material should be cared for thoughtfully to preserve its refined character.

For powder-coated stainless steel, wipe surfaces regularly with a soft, damp cloth and mild soap, then dry thoroughly. Avoid abrasive pads, harsh chemicals, or solvents that may damage the coating. To protect the finish, use felt pads or coasters under objects and clean spills promptly to prevent marks or stains.

For velvet upholstery, gently vacuum the surface with a soft brush attachment on a low setting to remove dust and keep the fibers fresh. If spills occur, blot immediately with a clean, dry cloth. Avoid rubbing, as this can push liquid deeper into the fabric and disturb the pile. Minor marks can be treated with a slightly damp cloth, and the velvet can be lightly brushed in the direction of the nap to restore its texture.

Keep velvet away from prolonged direct sunlight to prevent fading, and avoid excessive moisture. Pressure marks may be softened by lightly steaming the fabric from a distance and gently brushing the fibers back into place once dry. For deeper cleaning or persistent stains, professional upholstery cleaning is recommended.

With regular care, the combination of powder-coated stainless steel and velvet will maintain its elegance, balancing strength with softness for years to come.

This piece combines the strength of powder-coated stainless steel with the soft, tactile richness of velvet, creating a balance between durable structure and inviting comfort.

Powder-coated stainless steel offers a refined, resilient surface created by applying a protective powder finish to the metal. This coating enhances the steel's durability while giving it a smooth, even appearance with a subtle matte character. Resistant to wear and well suited for everyday use, powder-coated stainless steel provides a stable and long lasting foundation for contemporary furniture.

Paired with the metal is velvet upholstery, crafted from 100% wool. Its dense pile forms a soft, velvety surface that gently reflects light, giving the fabric depth and movement. The material feels warm and inviting while remaining strong and durable, making it suitable for furniture in private homes as well as high use environments such as hotels, lounges, and public spaces.

Together, powder-coated stainless steel and velvet create a refined contrast between strength and softness. The clean, architectural quality of the metal meets the warmth and texture of the fabric, resulting in furniture that feels both modern and timeless.
